### **Energy Transfer Crude Oil Company, LLC**

Energy Transfer Crude Oil Company, LLC ("ETCO") is developing a new pipeline to provide transportation service through a crude oil pipeline from point(s) of origin in the Midwest to the crude oil terminalling facilities of Sunoco Logistics Partners L.P. at Nederland, Texas ("SXL Nederland"), with various potential points of destination along the pipeline.

### **Highlights of Project**

- Subject to applicable legal requirements, Committed Shippers would have discounted rates compared to uncommitted shippers' volumes for the same origin and destination points.
- Subject to applicable legal requirements, the Prorationing Policy for the pipelines will provide for different allocation treatment for regular versus new shippers where prorationing of capacity is necessary, and that Committed Shippers shall be deemed regular shippers with historic shipment ratios throughout the term of their TSA based on the greater of their committed volumes or actual shipments of crude petroleum during such period.
- Committed Shippers would have the flexibility of selecting a term of 5, 7, or 10 years, depending on destination point.
- Committed Shippers' committed volume rates would not be exposed to construction cost risk of the pipeline projects.
- Anticipated commencement of service in 2016.

## **Binding Expansion Open Season**

Dakota Access and ETCO are pleased to announce a Binding Expansion Open Season ("Expansion Open Season") to solicit shipper commitments for transportation service for Bakken/Three Forks production to reach multiple markets through their respective pipeline systems. Dakota Access and ETCO each anticipate that the level of expansion transport capacity for Bakken/Three Forks production will be determined based on committed subscriptions made by shippers during the Expansion Open Season.

The Expansion Open Season includes options for local tariff service on the Dakota Access pipeline project to Patoka, Illinois and Cushing, Oklahoma. It also provides interested parties with the opportunity for joint tariff service from the Bakken/Three Forks play to Nederland, Texas through a commitment to both pipeline systems.

## **Expansion Open Season Process**

The Open Season will commence at **12:00 p.m. (CDT) on September 23rd, 2014.**

Bona fide potential shippers that desire to receive copies of the open season documents are required to execute a confidentiality agreement and may direct their requests for a confidentiality agreement to the following e-mail address: [dIDA\\_ETCO@energytransfer.com](mailto:dIDA_ETCO@energytransfer.com).

To execute the confidentiality agreement, a potential shipper must:
